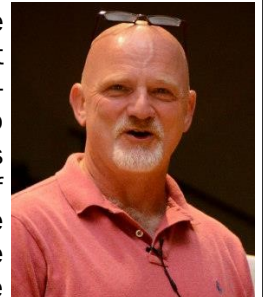

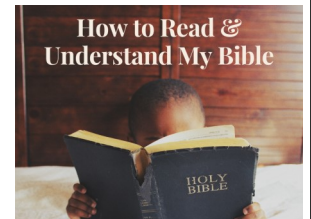


Wednesday Nights.
