Joe's Jots

Consider This When Using Social Media. The following is adapted from a blog post by Wes McAdams, a Texas preacher who writes for the website radicallychristian.com. Be blessed!

Social media can be beneficial and enjoyable, but only if it is used in a way that honors God. Sadly, we all know there is a lot that happens online which does not honor God; some of it is even done in His name. We must be incredibly careful before we post something. Consider some of these Proverbs when you're using social media.

1. Restrain Your Words. "Whoever restrains his words has knowledge, and he who has a cool spirit is a man of understanding. Even a fool who keeps silent is considered wise; when he closes his lips, he is deemed intelligent" (Proverbs 17:27-28). God's people need to know when to say something and when to restrain our words. We need to be people with a "cool spirit," as opposed to a hot temper.

2. Be a Bubbling Brook. "The words of a man's mouth are deep waters; the fountain of wisdom is a bubbling brook" (Proverbs 18:4). Strive to be a wise presence online. Let your words and the things you share be refreshing and life-giving. Words are so powerful. They can either heal or they can destroy. Choose your words wisely.

3. Take Pleasure in Understanding. "A fool takes no pleasure in understanding, but only in expressing his opinion" (Proverbs 18:2). The application of this passage is obvious, isn't it? Social media has magnified this kind of foolishness. We all want to share our opinion, but we don't want to listen. We don't want to understand. We just want to be heard. It's time for that to change.


