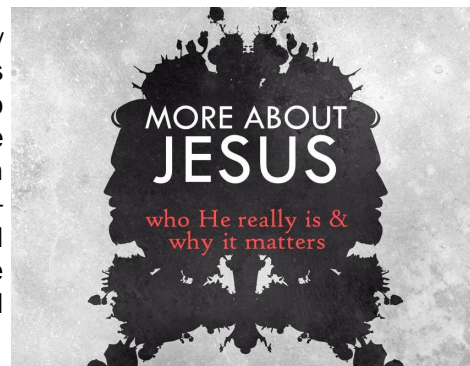

Joe's Jots

The Temple of God. Last week, we talked about how Jesus is the new and better temple. In the Old Testament, the temple was the special dwelling place of God. But it was always inadequate in satisfying our need for God's presence. It didn't contain the fullness of God, it could be (and was) destroyed, and it didn't administer God's presence to all people as it was intended. In contrast, Jesus manifests God's presence in a complete way—according to Paul, all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell in Him (**Col. 1:19**)! And Jesus cannot be destroyed. He was murdered on a cross, but was raised to new life on the third day. And finally, Jesus administers God's presence to *all* who place their faith in Him, regardless of ethnicity or nationality. He is the new and better temple, God with us, God dwelling among us. Let's talk about what God's presence in Jesus means for us. It provides...

- **Courage for the task** at hand. Whatever God commands us to do, wherever He directs us to go, He will be with us (**Matt. 28:20**). This should give us boldness to fulfill our mission.
- **Comfort in trial.** In our hardships, God's presence provides peace. He knows what we're going through (**Heb. 4:15**).
- **Challenge in temptation.** You can hide your secret sins from even those closest to you, but not from God. He sees all. And His presence empowers and spurs us to embrace uprightness.

Sermon Series. Our Sunday morning series about Jesus continues today. To truly grasp the identity of our Lord, we can't start reading the Bible in Matthew. We must start in Genesis and be introduced to all the concepts and people in the Old Testament who point ahead to the coming Christ...

Counseling Needs

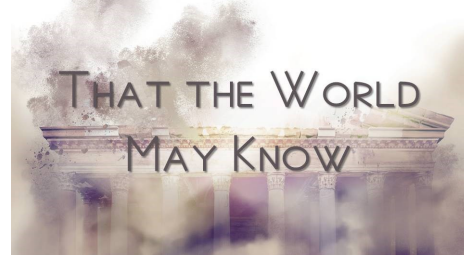
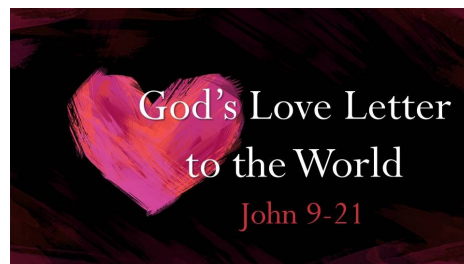
