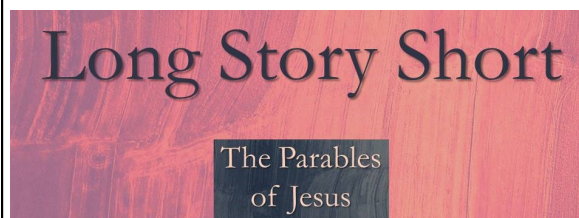

**Sermon Series.** I have enjoyed exploring the powerful parables of Jesus with you. We'll continue this through the end of March! Here's the schedule:

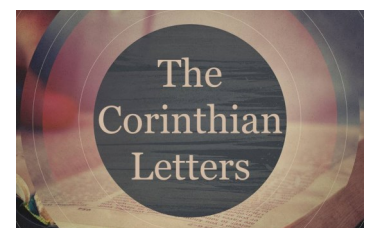
March 11: "The Fruitless Fig Tree" (Lk. 13:6-9)

**Politics.** It's fine for Christians to have political opinions, even strong ones. And it's fine for us to voice those opinions in respectful, loving ways. But when that's all we talk about around town or on social media, we start believing that's all there is. We start forgetting that our primary citizenship is in God's eternal Kingdom instead of a man-made temporary kingdom. Certainly, we should be thankful for our "dual citizenship," grateful to be Christians living in the United States. But we must remember that our job is not to convince our neighbors to embrace our opinions about this earthly nation in which we are sojourners. Our job is to show them there's a bigger, better, and greater Nation to which they can belong (1 Pet. 2:9). Our job is to lead them to the waters of baptism where they can enter that Nation. Strong political opinions are fine. But commitment to the unshakable Kingdom of Jesus must be stronger, and our support for it must be louder.
