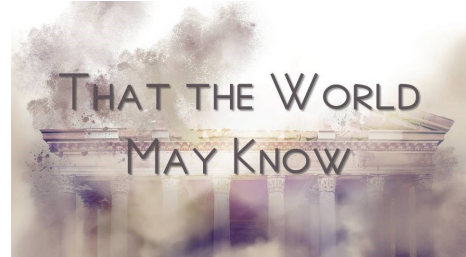
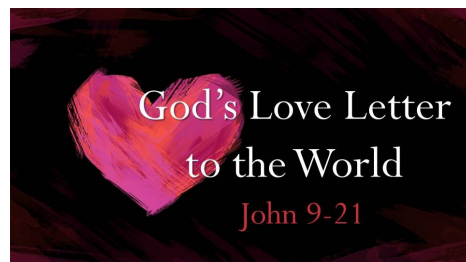
Memorial Donations
