6 PM Preview: Joseph will continue our series, "Pursuing Wisdom: A Study in Proverbs" with chapters 6-7. Join us!

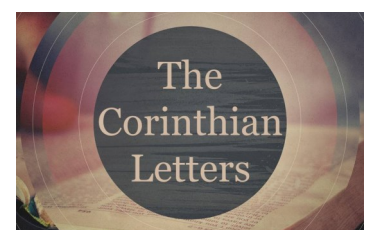
Joe's Jots
