Imitate Me. That's what Paul says in **1 Corinthians 11:1**: "Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ." Few of us would feel comfortable saying this to younger believers. It might sound arrogant escaping our lips, and what's more, we're not sure our lives are worth emulating. However, as one writer observes, Paul's statement "reflects wisdom: we learn who we are and how to act only by the example of others." We become people of faith by imitating people of faith. That's simply the way it works! The question for us: are we willing to present our own lives as models of Christ-like living? Will we be to others what our everyday heroes of faith have been to us? We might not ever say what Paul said, but we ought to *live* in a way that is worthy of imitation.

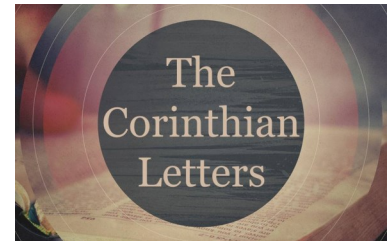
