**Church Work.** When most people hear the phrase "church work," they think only of activities that are officially organized by church leadership. But I believe "church work" also includes any action done by any church member for the glory of God (1 Cor. 10:31). Therefore, there's a lot of "church work" going on that never makes it into this bulletin and that's never announced from our pulpit. You are doing church work every time you have a conversation about your faith with a friend or neighbor. You're doing church work when you sit at the hospital during the surgery of a brother or sister. You're doing church work when you provide help to someone in need. All of this is church work because you, the baptized believer, are a member of the body of Christ (1 Cor. 12:27). The work you do is done in the name of the church of Christ to which you belong. So the next time you're tempted to ask a church leader, "What's the church doing about this or that?" ask instead, "What am I and my brothers and sisters, as members of the church, doing about it?" Christians, let's be about the work of the church this week!

**Galatians 5:22-24.** "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control: against such things there is no law. And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires."


