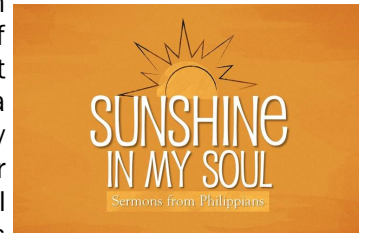

**Salvation.** Last Sunday morning, we talked about some basic yet vital Christian beliefs. Here's a recap. We established that salvation is a free gift of God that comes through our faith in Jesus Christ (Eph. 2:5, 8-9; Rom. 6:23). Christianity is built on the foundation of God's grace! We also learned that salvation is a way of life we're called to practice (Phil. 2:12). Salvation is a big enough reality for both meanings. While it takes no work to receive salvation, it does take some effort on our part to experience it fully. Yet even when we're "working out our salvation in fear and trembling," God is working in us to help us live faithfully (Phil. 2:13). We arrived at this conclusion: since salvation is both a gift from God and a lifestyle worked out by us, we can't have one aspect without the other. We can't receive salvation apart from God's grace. And we can't keep salvation apart from our faithful lives.
