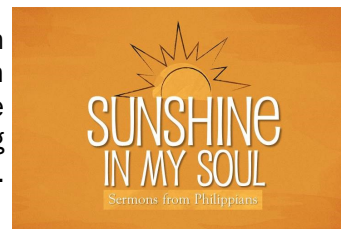

Joe's Jots

Philippians. Our Sunday morning sermon series on this letter of Paul comes to an end today! We've been tracing the theme of joy throughout the book and learning about what brings sunshine to our souls. Paul tells us we should find joy in...



- The process of spiritual growth that God has begun in us and will bring to completion when Jesus returns (Phil. 1:3-11).
- The proclamation of the gospel (Phil. 1:12-30).
- The peace and unity that Christians experience (Phil. 2:1-4).
- The promise that if we humble ourselves before God, He will exalt us (Phil. 2:5-11).
- The practice of our new salvation lifestyle (Phil. 2:12-18).
- The powerful examples of Christian mentors (Phil. 2:19-30).
- Placing our confidence not in the flesh but in Jesus Christ alone (Phil. 3:1-11).
- Pressing on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called us heavenward in Christ Jesus (Phil. 3:12-16).

The big message about joy that Paul wants us to hear is this: if you're seeking joy in any other source but Jesus Christ, you'll come up short. Every. Single. Time. I hope and pray these lessons have been as beneficial for your faith as they have been for mine!

Home Again. Last week, I had the privilege of speaking at VBS for the church where I grew up. I talked about Joseph and how God used the events and people in his life to shape him. I was reminded how God has used the Christians at the Red Bank church to shape me. It was humbling to have some of my old Sunday school teachers in my class! I firmly believe God was behind my family's decision to place membership at that congregation over 25 years ago. Without the influence of that church family, I probably would not have attended FHU, married Lauren, and become a minister. In other words, my life would be dramatically different today! I am in awe not only of God work's in biblical Joseph's life but also in *this* Joseph's life. We all should take more time to reflect on all the ways God has guided our steps and molded us into the people we have become. If we did, we would most certainly live with a greater sense of wonder before our mighty God!
