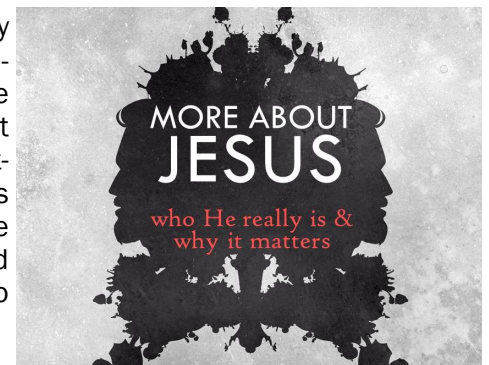

**The Great High Priest.** Last Sunday, we talked about Jesus as our great High Priest. What does that mean? There were priests under the law of Moses in the Old Testament to mediate a relationship between God and His people. Sinful people need someone to approach a holy God on their behalf. But this was always an inadequate arrangement: even the morally upright priests were less than perfect. Enter Jesus. The book of Hebrews is fixated on establishing Him as the new and better Priest. What makes him so? He is completely God and completely man. Who better than the Son of God to represent God to His people? And who better than the perfect Man to represent humanity before God? Jesus our High Priest is holy and unstained (**Heb. 7:26**). And Jesus our High Priest has been tempted in every way we are, yet without sin (**Heb. 4:15**). Because of Him, sinful creatures like us can now draw near God's throne with confidence (**4:16**). What a blessing!

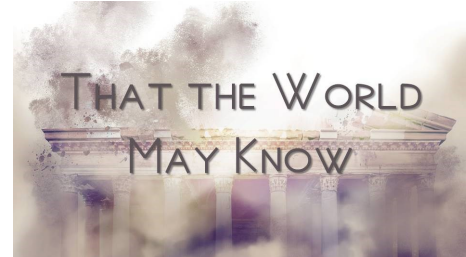
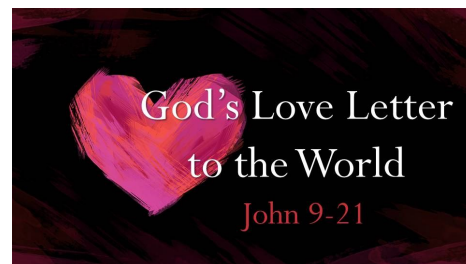
