Her genuine concern for this needy man whom she never met has put me to shame. And this tenderness of heart is not unique to Elise. It's something all young kids seem to possess. Surely this is the kind of thing Jesus had in mind when He said we must become like little children (Matt. 18:3).

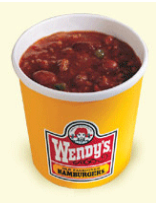
