Where Do We Go When We Die? This was the topic for last Sunday night's sermon. I want to include some of that material here for easy reference. To begin, we must make a distinction between death and the second coming of Christ. At Christ's return, the dead in Christ will be raised (1 Cor. 15:23, 1 Thess. 4:16), all who are in Christ will be changed (1 Cor. 15:51-53), judgment will occur (Matt. 25:31-33), and eternal life in the new heaven and earth will begin (Rev. 21-22). The question under consideration here is, what is the state of the faithful dead until Christ's return? The Bible offers some clues. First, those who die in the Lord Jesus are currently *with* the Lord Jesus. Jesus tells the faithful thief on the cross, "Today you will be with me in Paradise" (Luke 23:43). And Paul proclaims, "My desire is to depart and be with Christ" (Phil. 1:23). Second, those who die in Christ experience a period of rest ahead of His return. Revelation 6:11 and 14:13 refer to the souls of the dead saints resting from their earthly labor. And third, those who die in Christ are secured for an eternity spent with God. The voice from heaven in Revelation says, "Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on" (14:13). Though death is the result of sin (Rom. 6:23), Jesus conquers death (1 Cor. 15:55), making it an event that believers should no longer dread. The words of the Psalmist are truer now than ever before: "Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of his saints" (116:15). The souls of the faithful dead are awaiting the glorious return of Christ, the resurrection of their bodies, and the beginning of eternal life in God's presence. What good news!

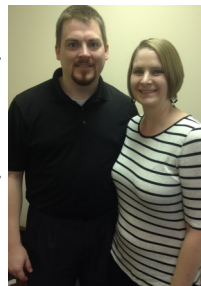
