However, as I told you in a recent sermon, I fully intend to finish the reading plan, even if it takes me into the new year. We are currently finalizing our theme for 2020—one we believe will give us all a common purpose and help us grow. We'll be sharing this theme during the morning worship hour on January 5. A new Wednesday adult class centered on this theme will begin on January 8. I'm excited about our 2020 theme and I hope you will be too. Start praying that we will glorify God and help grow His kingdom in the new year!

Crazy Calendars. 'Tis the season when our schedules are filled with many good and worthwhile events, when we are giving of our time and resources for the well-being of others. Here are some helpful words that might provide needed perspective: "Paul was busy, in all the right ways. If you love God and serve others, you will be busy too. Sometimes we will get frazzled. We will feel pressure. We will be tired. We will get discouraged. We will feel exhausted. We will say, 'Who is weak, and I am not weak?' (2 Cor. 11:29). But be encouraged. God uses weak things to shame the strong (1 Cor. 1:27). His grace is sufficient for you; his power is made perfect in weakness (2 Cor. 12:9). For the sake of Christ, we must be content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities. And yes, sometimes we must be content with busyness. For when you are weak, then you are strong (v. 10) Paul had pressure. You have pressure too. But God can handle the pressure. Do not be surprised when you face crazy weeks of all kinds. And do not be surprised when God sustains you in the midst of them."
