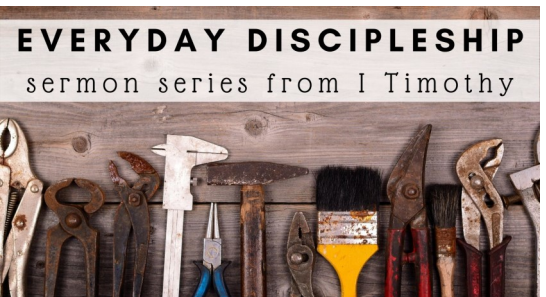

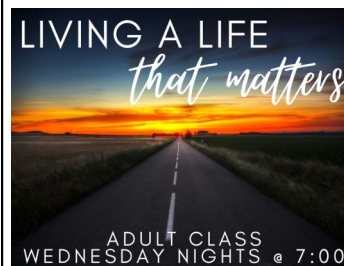
Joe's Jots
