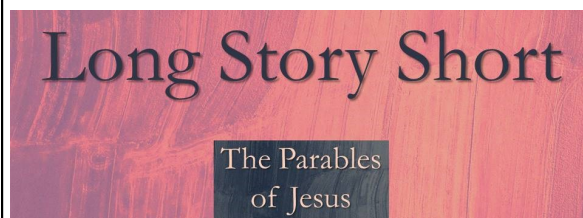

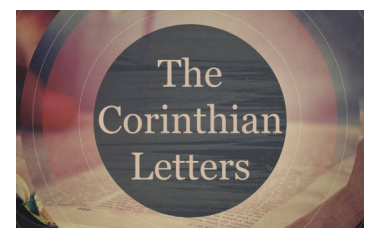
### New Sermon Series.

**Another One.** We witnessed yet another horrific mass shooting last week, this one at a high school in Lakeland, Florida. It brought to my mind the shooting at Columbine almost nineteen years ago. I vividly remember it—many of the students killed were close to my age. The tagline on the news coverage said "High School Massacre" and my mom was disturbed by that last word, "massacre." She wished they would replace it with a different word. But that's precisely what it was. Everyone was horrified by what happened. I'm afraid we're a little less horrified today, that we're a little too numb to the violence. Yet we must allow ourselves to feel the horror of it. Only then will we work to advance God's peaceable Kingdom. Only then will we long for that Kingdom to come in its fullness. Truly, it can't come soon enough.
