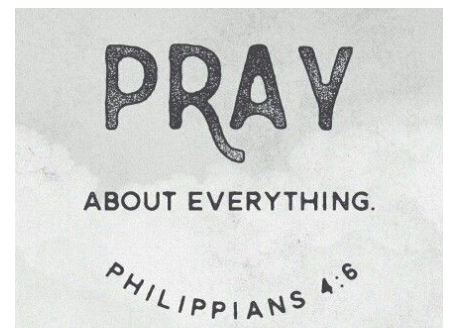
George Winters, father of Stacey Dotson, who is struggling with advanced Alzheimer's.
