**Sunday Sermon Series.** Today, we are kicking off the new year with a sermon series called "Looking for Jesus in Luke." I read recently about a young man who had a crisis of faith and found himself "staring into the chasm of unbelief." A trusted mentor gave him some advice that changed his life: "Go back and read the Gospels and look for Jesus." I can't think of a better "palate cleanser," a better way to start 2026 than by looking into the life & ministry of our Lord. A couple things: first, this is a Sunday morning AND evening series. So I challenge you to be present at BOTH to experience all that Luke's gospel has to offer. Second, I also challenge you to read the entire gospel of Luke. Hopefully you've already had a chance to do that. If not, it will take you about 2 and a half hours total. I'm excited to dive in today. Let's go!
