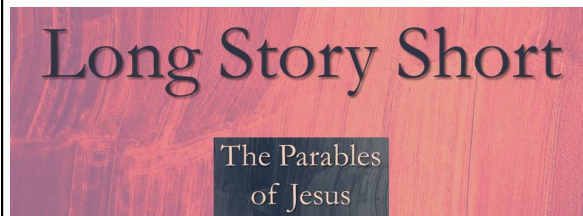

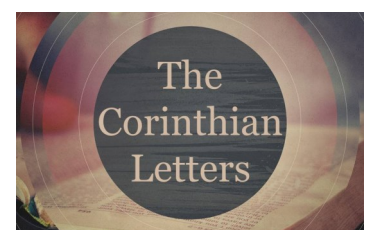
Today, we begin a new series on Jesus' parables. I'm excited to explore these powerful stories! Here's the schedule:
