Thanksgiving. President George Washington proclaimed a day of thanksgiving in 1789, but for many decades after, each state scheduled its own Thanksgiving holiday at different times. That all changed on October 3, 1863 when President Abraham Lincoln made a proclamation that set apart the last Thursday of November as a national day of Thanksgiving. [Since 1941, it has been celebrated on the fourth Thursday.] Lincoln's proclamation is worth reading in full, but here's what he wrote after enumerating the many blessings experienced by our country: "No human counsel hath devised nor hath any mortal hand worked out these great things. They are the gracious gifts of the Most High God, who, while dealing with us in anger for our sins, hath nevertheless remembered mercy. It has seemed to me fit and proper that they should be solemnly, reverently and gratefully acknowledged as with one heart and one voice by the whole American People." Thanksgiving affords Christians the opportunity to not only consider the blessings of living in this great land, but more importantly to thank God for the blessings of belonging to His eternal kingdom. The Psalmist declares, "Give thanks to the LORD, for He is good. His love endures forever" (**Psalm 136:1**). I hope you have a blessed Thanksgiving and that every day you take time to say, "Thank you, Lord!"
