Joe's Jots

Sermon Series. I'm wrapping up a three-part sermon series today called "Behold Our God." We've been looking at comparisons the Bible makes to Sunday Morning Sermon Series God and what these teach us about



his greatness and majesty. I'm glad you're here this morning!

Lord's Supper. Today, we resume a practice that has been on hiatus since March 2020-passing communion and offering trays in our worship assembly. We're changing not because the way we've been taking communion and giving of our means is wrong. The elders simply believe this new/old way is better. I can think of many reasons why. (1) Passing communion trays reminds us of the communal nature of the Lord's Supper-it's an act of worship we do together. (2) It also creates more natural time to reflect on the meaning of the Lord's Supper. (3) Passing offering trays allows our young children to see grown-ups giving to kingdom work, and gives them an opportunity to begin giving as well. (4) Passing trays provides more opportunities for men to lead/serve in worship. I hope and pray that resuming this practice will enrich our worship to the Lord together!
