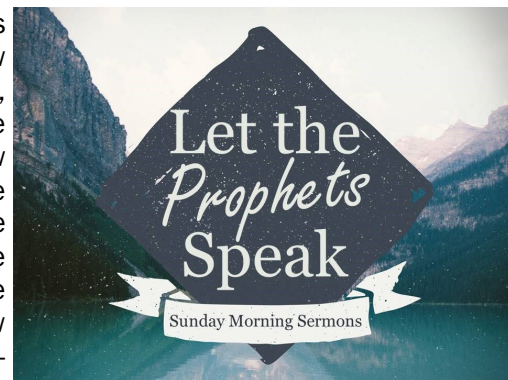

Joe's Jots

New Sermon Series. This morning, I am starting a new preaching series on Amos, Hosea, and Micah. The books of the Bible I know the least about are the minor prophets. You may be in the same boat! But since there are several (12 to be exact), I needed to narrow our scope. The three prophetic books we're digging



into were written during the same time period, the 8th century BC. We'll be discovering how these ancient words from God can speak to us today. Be praying that this series will be a beneficial and transformational study for all of us!

BREAD, which stands for Brethren Rejoicing, Edifying, and Dining, is a program which promotes fellowship by pairing two families together so they can share a meal. If you have signed up for this program, check out the bulletin board in the lobby for pairings for the current quarter!

A Text. In a sermon a few weeks ago, I asked everyone to pull out their phones and text someone they were concerned about spiritually. I have heard from several of you about your experience doing that. Someone texted his sister, and he has since been studying the Bible with her. Someone else texted a family member who has not been with us in a while—the person contacted said she missed coming to church at Winchester. Someone else texted a young family member, encouraging this person to put on Christ in baptism. If you have yet to share your experience texting someone that morning, I would love to hear about it! God can use something as small as a text to make a big impact. It was on the Saturday evening before that Sunday morning sermon that I decided to ask everyone to send a text. I thought to myself, "If I'm expecting everyone else to reach out to someone, then I ought to as well." So I sent a text that evening. And the person I texted responded to the invitation the next morning and was baptized into Christ. Now, I'm not saying the text from me was the sole reason he decided to be baptized. But I believe it played a role in that decision by offering some encouragement. You never know what God is going to do with our small, faithful actions, even the sending of a text!
