## Joe's Jots

**Eclipse.** I stuck around our church building to witness the solar eclipse with the WCA students on Monday. In our area, over 98% of the sun was briefly blocked by the moon and it was amazing to witness. However, several of you traveled just a few miles to our north or east to experience 100% totality. And you've told me it was absolutely stunning to see the world go dark for a minute or two in mid-afternoon. I'm amazed that less than 2% of the sun's rays can make such a huge difference. It's a reminder to me that a tiny bit of light can illuminate a world of darkness. Let us not forget that even in this world full of the darkness of sin, one faithful believer can make a huge impact. "Let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven" (Matt. 5:16).



**A Special Visit.** Our sister **Ruth Julian** worshipped with us last Sunday during a week-long visit to our area. At 96, Ruth would be our oldest member if she still lived here. And she's as feisty and faithful as ever! When she and **Jean Jones** came to visit the office one day, Ruth said to me, "My mouth is what gets me in trouble.
