We'll look at how the gospel of Jesus Christ speaks to each of these common struggles. These lessons will be highly practical so invite friends and family members to join us!

Suffering. Last week's word was suffering. There aren't many more difficult subjects! On Sunday night, I shared some strategies for dealing with suffering as Christians. Here are three: **(1) Remind yourself of the fallen nature of our world.** Most human suffering arises from the sin-sickness that plagues our planet. **(2) Allow yourself to feel the pain of it.** Jesus still wept at Lazarus' tomb even though he knew he would raise him from the dead. **(3) Stress the temporary nature of suffering.** Our current hurt can't compare with our future glory (2 Cor. 4:17).
