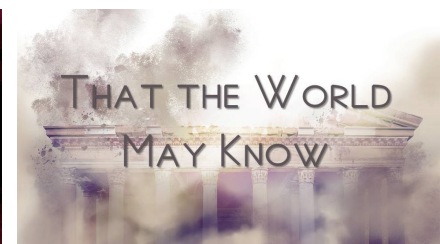
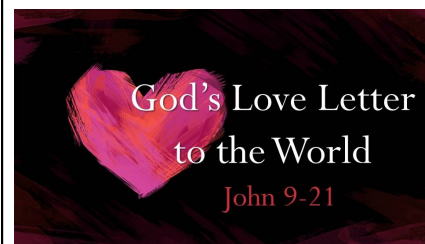

What Will You Do With Jesus? Standing at the center of the Bible and human history is one man who is much more than a man. He is the long-awaited Messiah, the Son of God, God Himself in the flesh.
