Proverbs. I have greatly enjoyed our study of the Proverbs on Sunday nights so far this year! Last Wednesday, since our Bible classes were cancelled due to snow, I listened to the first five chapters of Proverbs. Here was one of the many passages that struck me, from **4:18-19**: "The path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, which shines brighter and brighter until full day. The way of the wicked is like deep darkness; they do not know over what they stumble." When we walk in the way of wisdom, rooted in the reverence of God, our journey becomes increasingly clearer and brighter until the glorious Day of the Lord. But rejecting God brings confusion and darkness, to the point that people can't understand why none of their choices brings satisfaction. The Proverbs writer warns that a life without wisdom from God brings misery. I can't wait to keep exploring the Proverbs with you!

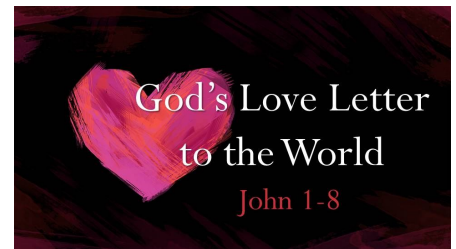
We extend our sympathy to Andy Groves and his family on the passing of his brother Edwin Austin Groves. Arrangements were incomplete at time of publishing.
