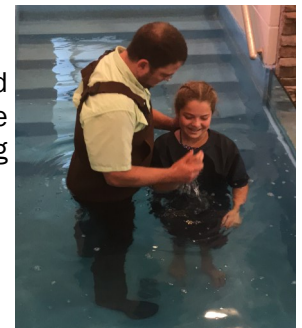

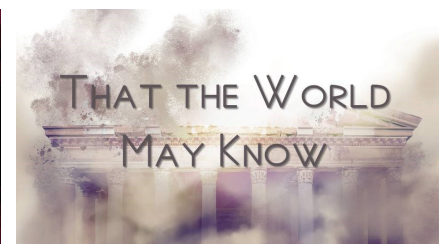
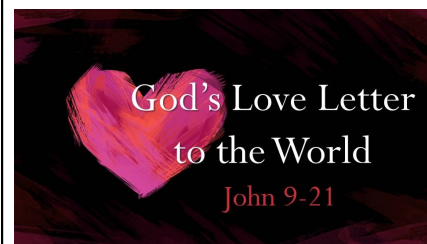

**Race and the Church.** In a recent opinion piece, David Brooks writes, "As a nation we seem to have lost all enthusiasm for racial integration." It seems the church has too. It hasn't always been this way. When the restoration movement swept through this county and a church of New Testament Christians sprang up in the Old Salem community, the believers embraced radical integration. From its founding in May of 1834, the congregation was comprised of both white and black members. By Christmas that year, the church had grown to thirty-four whites and twelve blacks. That same year, the Lipscomb family, who were charter members of the congregation, moved to Illinois for the express purpose of freeing their slaves. Our spiritual ancestors believed that racial disunity was inconsistent with the Scriptures. From the beginning of the Bible, when the father and mother of all humanity were created in the image of God, to the end, when people from all nations and tribes praise God as one in heaven, the Bible envisions racial harmony. The church of today should be a living example of this vision.
