New Sermon Series. Daniel is preaching the latest message in our sermon series called **We Belong Together**. We're talking about how we can foster togetherness and healthy connections as brothers and sisters in Christ! I'm glad you're here today!

Seeing Others. Last week, in our **We Belong Together** sermon series, I talked about seeing others well, and making them feel seen. Someone once said, "Paying attention is the purest form of love." There are many barriers to seeing others well, like egotism, anxiety, unfair assumptions, and a fixed mindset about who someone is. Seeing others well in the body of Christ begins with seeing them as God sees them: people made in the image of God for whom Christ died and who are God's children through faith. What are some mindsets we should possess if we want to make people feel seen? First, **curiosity** helps us to marvel at the uniqueness of every human made in God's likeness. Second, **charity** means we assume the best about others as we interact with them. Third, **compassion** keeps us sensitive to the experiences of others. We can show our compassion or genuine concern by looking people in the eye when speaking, and calling them by their name. Seeing others well will bless them, transform us, and please our God, who was once called El Roi, "the God of seeing" (**Genesis 16:13**). So let's show our love by paying attention to one another! This will help us to be joined together in harmony as God intends.
